2026 PROJECTS

CBCC's projects focus on natural resource preparedness to protect our territory's watersheds and the people that live within them.

Watershed Education Program: Educating Virgin Islands youth on how the watershed they live in can impact them and be protected.

Coastal Resilience: Designing resiliency solutions to protect infrastructure and critical marine ecosystems by mitigating sedimentation and flooding. This project is made possible with a grant from the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation.

Ecosystem Monitoring: Investing in innovative marine technologies and water quality monitoring to study climate change and aid in protecting our watershed. These include a smart buoy, weather monitoring stations, webcams, and a Citizen Science Program.

Drinking Water & Wastewater Assistance: Improving drinking water and wastewater infrastructure in homes and small businesses, focused on Coral Bay, St. John.



SMALL ORGANIZATION, BIG IMPACT

Mangrove Restoration

CBCC planted mangroves in Coral Harbor in a vulnerable part of Coral Bay. Mangrove restoration in this area is important in trying to bolster a protective barrier to help protect an important access road and infrastructure.



Smart Buoy Installed

Stormwater Infrastructure

Watershed Consultants visited Coral Bay neighborhoods to help residents locate, identify, and assess their stormwater structures. This work aims to mitigate the amount of sediment that flows into the bay and protect our community's homes from major land slides.
